- MOTION FROM EXEC: As a pilot study for the Fall 2015 registration period, for select courses, both on-line and on-ground, the waitlist number would be increased by the same number as the class size limit number (e.g., a class set at 28 would have a waitlist of 28, a class set at 45 would have a waitlist of 45). “Targeted” courses would be those high-demand courses identified by deans for which an increased waitlist may provide relevant scheduling information. Faculty assigned to those targeted sections will have the opportunity to opt out of the pilot study. Additional sections of targeted courses should be offered when there are enough students on the waitlist.
- MOTION FROM EXEC: To expose our students to political and civic leaders from our District and to introduce those same leaders to our professors and students, the Senate encourages instructors in appropriate disciplines to invite government officials and representatives from non-governmental organizations to present pertinent academic topics.
