**To Be Certified In The Program Students Must:**

- Attend an honors orientation meeting
- Complete any 6 honors courses (18 units)
- Complete all general education transfer requirements (IGETC)
- Achieve an overall college GPA of at least 3.2
- Complete all lower division prerequisites for their transfer major as established by the transfer school
- Meet with the Honors Counselor at least **twice** every semester while in the program
- Complete an exit interview with the Honors Coordinator or Counselor, or complete the survey online.

**Become an active participant!**

**Honors Section Enrollment** – Enrollment in honors sections is open to all continuing students who have completed English 101 with at least a “C” grade. First semester RHC students may enroll in honors sections if they are also should enrolled in English 101 and have permission from the Program Director, Rebecca Green, or Honors Counselor, Martha De La Mora. *First semester students are not eligible for English 201H or Psychology 210H. Note that there are additional prerequisites for Math 130H and Psychology 210H.*

**Honors Transfer Program Membership** – To be an active participant in the program, beginning students must have a high school GPA of 3.2 and should enroll in English 101 in their first semester. Continuing students must have a GPA of 3.2 for all transferable college courses, and must have completed English 101 with an “A” or “B.” Students must enroll in at least one honors course each semester. All active participants are required to attend an honors orientation meeting before or during their first semester in the program. They must also meet with the Honors Counselor twice each semester. Students do not have to be active participants in the program to enroll in honors sections.

**RHC is A Member Of The UCLA Transfer Alliance Program (TAP) And The Honors Transfer Council Of California (HTCC)**

- RHC has honors transfer agreements with UCLA, UC Irvine, UC Riverside, UC Santa Cruz, California State University Fullerton, California State University Long Beach, California State University San Diego, Chapman College, Loyola Marymount, Pomona College, Pitzer College, Whitman College (Washington), Pacific University (Oregon), and San Diego State University.
- Students who have completed the RHC Honors Transfer Program are now enrolled at USC, UCLA, UC Riverside, UC Santa Cruz, UC Berkeley, Cal Poly Pomona, Cal State Fullerton, Brown University, and Cornell University.
