

COLOR WORDS

RED:	Scarlet, cardinal, vermilion, carmine, crimson, pink, rose, cherry, salmon, maroon, carnation, magenta, damask.
Hair:	Sandy, carrot, brick red, Titian, auburn, chestnut, strawberry blond.
Red-Complexion:	Red-faced, florid, burned, rubicund, ruddy, red, highcolored, glowing, sanguine, blooming, rosy, hectic, flushed, inflamed.
Reddish-brown:	Terra cotta, russet, bronze, coppery, copper-colored, chestnut, henna, hazel, auburn, rust-colored.
BROWN:	Nut brown, seal brown, mahogany, chocolate, fawn, tawny, tan, fawn-colored, snuff-colored, liver-colored, copper, bronze, light brown, golden brown, tawny, ash-warm-medium-dark-coffee brown.
ORANGE:	Orange- (or gold, brass, apricot) colored, warm, hot, glowing, flame colored.
YELLOW:	Blond: golden, gilt, gilded, lemon, sallow (a yellowish sickly hue), creamy, flaxen, yellowish, buff, corn-silk, honey-blond, ash-blond, pale yellow, dun, gold colored (or saffron, citron, lemon, amber, straw, primrose, cream, brass) champagne, beige, frosted.
PURPLE:	Violet, plum, lavender, lilac, puce, mauve, purplish, amethystine, magenta.
BLUE:	Azure, indigo, sapphire, sky-blue, steel blue, midnight-blue, robin's egg blue, baby blue, aquamarine, electric-blue, bluish.
GREEN:	Verdant, olive, emerald-green, or pea-, grass, apple, sea, leaf, bottle-green, Kelly, aquamarine, blue-, turquoise, greenish.
WHITE:	Snow-white, snowy, frosted, silvery, milk-white, milky, creamy, pearly, ivory, fair, blanched, light, tow-headed, whitish.
GRAY:	Iron gray, dun, drab, dingy, leaden, pearly, dove-colored, silver, silvery, dapple, gray, ashen, ashy, grizzled, salt and

pepper.

BLACK:	Sable, somber, livid (like the color of a bruise), dark, inky, ebony, blotchy, smudgy, low-toned.
COLORELESSNESS :	Uncolored, hueless, pale, pallid, pale-faced, anemic, faint, dull, cold, muddy, leaden, dun, wan, sallow, dingy, ashy, ashen, ghastly, cadaverous, glassy, lackluster, discolored.
COLOR ADJECTIVES:	Bright, vivid, intense, deep, fresh, rich, gorgeous, gay, gaudy, florid, garish, showy, flaunting, flashy, many-colored, party-color, variegated, raw, crude, glaring, flaring, mellow, harmonious, pearly, sweet, delicate, subtle, tender, dull, sad somber, grave, gray, dark.
HAIR:	<p>Hair may be described according to its tone, color, hue, shape, shades, shading, streaks, luster, etc.</p> <p>It may be full, healthy, lustrous, opulent, elegant, luxuriant, full-bodied, glossy, shimmering, fine, stringy, soft, sleek, matted, coarse, thick, thin, etc.</p> <p>It may be loose, tousled, natural, or it may be rigorously styled (the "cast iron permanent")</p> <p>It may be long, mid-length, shoulder-length, free-swinging, short, molded close to the head, stubby, bristly, etc.</p> <p>It may feature bangs, curls, waves, loops, a tumble of waves, braided, etc.</p> <p>It may cover the face, frame the face, be upswept, tightly pulled away from face.</p>
EYES:	Eyes may be wide-eyed, saucer-eyed, soft-eyed, sloe-eyed, red-eyed, gimlet-eyed, pouchy, heavy-lidded, beady, etc.
FACES:	Fine boned, sensitive, coarse, fleshy, spare, gaunt, oval, round, moon faced, narrow, beetle-browed, hawk-faced, horse-faced, fish-faced, etc.
NOSES:	Full, snub-nosed, put-nosed, long, short, beaked, aquiline, classic, flat-nosed, flaring nostrils, etc.

BODIES: Muscular, muscle-bound, hulking, short-legged, slender, lithe, willowy, pudgy, flabby, flaccid, obese, gaunt, big-boned, massive, blocky, petite, demure, diminutive, etc.
