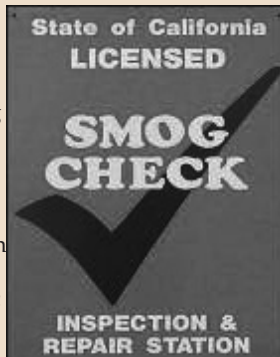

Art of Authentic Latino Leadership, Certificate Program



Latinos are quickly becoming the majority group in California and a much larger minority group in the United States and are already the majority in LA County. Latinos have the potential for tremendous visibility and impact. However, there is a vacuum of strong, prepared leadership. At the same time, the boomers are beginning to leave a vacuum of leadership in all sectors, Governmental, Nonprofit and Corporate. How will Latinos prepare themselves in this time of crisis without accessible training and mentorship?

The Certificate Program in the Art of Authentic Latino Leadership provides a forum to discuss specific leadership development topics from a Latino/Hispanic perspective. As a participant, you will learn how to become a stronger leader, and grasp ways to enhance and strengthen your personal credibility and success as an emerging leader in your community. The five times we meet we will offer provocative and stimulating discussion. Participants will address key issues from personal, interpersonal, and organizational perspectives. You will explore how to best use your cultural competency, vision, passion, commitment and character within the Latino context of social, economic, cultural, and political power and how to maximize your talents.

Framing Leadership in the Latino Context: Latino Leadership Framework, Demographics, Economics and Outlook. Pillars of leadership and its evolution over time. Identify Authentic Latino Leaders, deconstruct their characteristics. Identify other authentic Leaders, Mentors, and books on the topic. Charting your map towards leadership with an Individual Development Plan. Connection between personal mission and vision and leadership.

Latino Leadership: Authentic Alignment & Overcoming the Ego's Attraction to Power Character Development vs. Leadership Development. Self awareness and a discussion on Credibility, Capacity, Character as pillars of overcoming the attraction to power over the greater good. Alignment of values and personal mission with organizational mission.

Powerful Communications and Conflict Transformation in the Latino Context: What drives communications? Non verbal Communications, Art of Listening and its relationship to the Art of Leadership. Conflict Transformation, Team Building & Communications & Coaching. External Communications and Influence. The Art of Listening. This section includes an exercise entitled "Mini Lecture & Teaching One Another" where the participants demonstrate their ability to listen and then teach what they learned to someone else in the workshop, thus practicing both speaking and listening.
