

### **GRACE Application Packet 2018-2019**

#### Mission

GRACE connects students who have interests in government relations or public relations with opportunities to learn what is needed to maintain healthy government and community relations and to provide courteous, timely, and professional representation of Rio Hondo College. By providing servant leadership at events on and off campus, GRACE helps enhance the image of Rio Hondo College.

#### Vision

The Office of Government & Community Relations (GCR) trains Rio Hondo College students who have interests in the area of government relations, community relations, or public relations, so that they are equipped with experiences in GRACE which will enable them to succeed in government relations jobs and/or careers.

#### Requirements

Students applying to GRACE must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Not be on academic or disciplinary probation
- Pay the \$9 transportation fee
- Be able to commit to Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 (with the opportunity to renew in Summer 2019)
- Must be available for monthly mandatory meetings on Friday mornings (exact time to be determined)
- Not currently be an ASRHC Ambassador
- Be a current Rio Hondo student (i.e. not be in high school)
- Accept that GRACE is a volunteer, non-paid position

#### **Expectations**

Students who pledge to participate in GRACE will be expected to have or value the following:

- Sensitivity to diversity
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Knowledge of current events at the federal, state, and local levels of government and how they impact students at Rio Hondo College
- Appreciation of professional development and a willingness to undergo personal and professional growth

#### **Training**

All students in GRACE are required to attend an orientation/ training meeting. All training dates will be provided in advance and all members of GRACE are expected to attend. Furthermore, all students will be asked to participate in the Student Leadership Institute which will be organized by Student Life and Leadership in partnership with ASRHC and Cal State Fullerton.

#### **Evaluation**

At the end of the first six months GRACE members are evaluated based on their performance and in turn have an opportunity to evaluate the GRACE program. If the Office of GCR and the GRACE members mutually agree to continue, GRACE students may renew their service in Summer 2019.
