Motion made by Brian Brutlag to amend the draft by-laws to have a two-year term limit for faculty with the option to continue with a second term

Meta-majors:

Discussion of naming of meta-majors; many divisions have not had the opportunity to meet and discuss the naming since last GPS Committee meeting; how do we approach meta-majors and what is the purpose/intent of their use (philosophical grouping of interest areas vs. looking at what programs have overlapping coursework requirements?); what is a reasonable/appropriate number of meta-majors to present to students?; broad interest areas that will allow programs to be placed in multiple interest areas; it was suggested that we have “homework” to come up with ideas for approximately 10 areas of interest that will then be vetted by divisions; how do we capture 4-year majors that aren’t necessarily part of a program at RHC (can be presented as “foundation” courses); importance of looking at RHC’s website design

Motion made by Vann Priest to stop using the term “meta-majors” and replace it with “areas of interest”

Seconded by Juana Mora
