New Credit Course

PHIL 122 Philosophical Perspectives on Death & Dying

Description

This course introduces students to a broad array of themes associated with death and dying. Students consider both practical and philosophical aspects of death, comparing the concept of death historically, socially, psychologically, and cross-culturally. Current legal, medical, and ethical issues related to death and dying will be explored through the lens of philosophy, with topics that may include suicide, euthanasia, moral and social issues stemming from modern medical technology, hospice and palliative care, end-of-life issues, violent deaths, mass killings, and the beliefs and customs of various cultures worldwide concerning death and the possibility of an afterlife. This course is well suited for students interested in the humanities, law, medicine, politics, social science and related fields, or for those seeking to improve their ability to process and respond to death and dying in a healthy manner.

NBIZ 007 Introduction to Information Systems

Description

This course introduces students to computer concepts and information systems that support the productive use of digital technology for a variety of personal and work-related tasks. Designed for students with limited computer experience, the course provides orientation to common operating systems and applications useful for online communication, digital media sharing, and personal data organization, including personal finance management. Attention is given to Internet navigation safety, information privacy, and digital security protections.

V. <u>DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

1. Elizabeth Ramirez – How to cite OER in the COR.

Elizabeth Ramirez shared a document with examples of how to properly site OER in CurrlQunet under the textbook tab. The document will be available on the Curriculum Webpage for reference.

2. Elizabeth Ramirez – Emergency Distance Ed approval for Spring 2022.

3. Elizabeth Ramirez – Follow up on FYS courses

Elizabeth reported back to the committee that Barbara Salazar confirmed that the Title V Avance grant ended in Fall 2020. Due to this information, she asked that the committee members get feedback from their divisions as to whether the courses should be deleted from the catalog or from curriculum.

Melissa Rifino-Juarez reported there was a possibility that Guided Pathways may be revising these courses to be used for incoming Freshman in the Summer Bridge program. Ted Preston heard that it was possible the courses would be reduced to 1 unit.

Elizabeth then asked Division Members to discuss with their divisions and confirm whether the courses will be revised or removed from curriculum.

Elizabeth shared a document prepared by Christian Vaca and Mike Garabedian that provides instruction on the preparation of Course Revisions in CurrlQunet. Elizabeth will be forwarding the document to all Division Reps as well as uploading to the Curriculum webpage.
