Description

NBAS 032 Chemistry I

Description

This physical science course introduces students to the fundamental nature of matter and its interactions. Topics include atomic and electronic structure, the nomenclature of compounds, chemical calculations, stoichiometry, bonding and shapes of molecules, and chemical reactions. Relevant laboratory exercises are an essential component of the course.

Description

This physical science course introduces students to matter and its interactions. Relevant laboratory exercises are an essential component of the course.

Students develop reading strategies and apply the writing process to compose essays that demonstrate use of precise language, rhetorical devices, and domain-specific vocabulary.

This course expands on the foundational understanding of literary elements. Students are introduced to strategies for close reading of texts and writing expository and argumentative compositions. Students apply rhetorical methods to explore themes in works of literature and apply the writing process to compose essays that demonstrate an organization of ideas supported by textual evidence.
