New Credit Course

ADN 130 Foundational Concepts of Nursing

Description

This course introduces the nursing student to foundational concepts across the lifespan. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 130 and ADN 130L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 130L Foundational Concepts of Nursing Lab

Description

This course introduces the nursing student to foundational concepts across the lifespan. Principles of safety, care competencies, health care infrastructure, attributes and roles are included. The application of concepts through clinical skills is experienced through seminar, lab and/or clinical settings. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 130 and ADN 130L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 131 Healthcare Participant

Description

This course introduces nursing students to the attributes of the health care participant as an individual, a family, or a community. Curricular concepts are applied in seminar, lab and clinical settings. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 131 and ADN 131L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

Description

The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 131 and ADN 131L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

Description

This course introduces students to pharmacologic nursing practice from a conceptual approach. Emphasis is placed on the drug classifications, prototypes, actions, interactions, adverse effects, and nursing implications. Curricular concepts, related to pharmacological modalities, are applied in seminar and laboratory settings. Students are encouraged to utilize the nursing process and clinical judgment while engaging with these curricular concepts. Upon completion of the course, students will apply pharmacological principles and interventions to provide safe and effective nursing care.

ADN 133 Maternal Newborn Health Concepts

Description

This course focuses on maternal and newborn health concepts. Emphasis is placed on reproduction, sexuality, homeostasis, regulation and emotion. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 133 and ADN 133L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

Description

This course focuses on maternal and newborn health concepts. Emphasis is placed on reproduction, sexuality, homeostasis, regulation and emotion. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 133 and ADN 133L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

Description

This course focuses on pediatric health concepts. Emphasis is placed on attributes and resources; homeostasis and regulation. ADN 230L Mental Health Concepts Lab

Description

This course focuses on mental health concepts across the lifespan. Concepts emphasized include coping and stress tolerance, emotion, cognitive function, and maladaptive behavior. Curricular concepts are

applied in seminar, lab and clinical settings. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 230 and ADN 230L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 231 Nursing Health and Illness Concepts II

Description

This course focuses on health and illness concepts for complex acute and chronic conditions across the lifespan. Emphasis is placed on concepts including oxygenation, homeostasis and regulation, protection and movement, and coping. Professional nursing concepts include selected professional attributes and care competencies. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 231 and ADN 231L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 231L Nursing Health and Illness Concepts II Lab

Description

This course focuses on health and illness concepts for complex acute and chronic conditions across the lifespan. Professional nursing concepts include selected professional attributes and care competencies. Curricular concepts are applied in seminar, lab and clinical settings. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. ADN 232 Pharmacology II

Description

This course continues the study of pharmacology from a conceptual approach as they relate to nursing management of drug therapy. Emphasis is placed on the drug classifications, prototypes, actions, interactions, adverse effects, and nursing implications. Complex curricular concepts, related to pharmacological modalities, are applied in seminar settings. Students are encouraged to utilize the nursing process and clinical reasoning while engaging with these curricular concepts. Upon completion of the course, students will apply pharmacological principles and interventions to provide safe and effective nursing care.

ADN 233 Nursing Health and Illness Concepts III

Description

This course focuses on health and illness concepts for care of individuals with multisystem and emergent health conditions across the lifespan. Concepts include homeostasis and regulation, protection and movement, and maladaptive behavior. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 233 and ADN 233L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 233L Nursing Health and Illness Concepts III Lab

Description

This course focuses on health and illness concepts for care of individuals with multisystem and emergent health conditions across the lifespan. Concepts include homeostasis and regulation, protection and movement, and maladaptive behavior. Curricular concepts are applied in seminar, lab and clinical settings. Upon completion, students will provide safe nursing care incorporating the concepts identified. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 233 and ADN 233L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

New Credit Course

ADN 234 Nursing Health and Illness Concepts IV

Description

The focus of this course is on the theoretical and clinical application of the Nursing Process and Clinical Judgment when providing care for patients across the lifespan. This course facilitates the transition from student nurse to graduate nurse. The student participates as a preceptee or mentee/member of the healthcare team and assumes responsibility for a group of patients under the direct supervision of a registered nurse or a non-faculty preceptor. Course content includes professional nursing and healthcare concepts. By the end of this course, the graduate is expected to function satisfactorily within the Nurse of the Future Competencies. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 234 and ADN 234L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

ADN 234L Nursing Health and Illness Concepts IV Lab

Description

The focus of this course is on the theory and clinical application of the Nursing Process and Clinical Judgment when providing care for patients across the lifespan. This course facilitates the transition from student nurse to graduate nurse. The student participates as a preceptee or mentee/member of the healthcare team and assumes responsibility for a group of patients under the direct supervision of a registered nurse or a non-faculty preceptor. Course content includes professional nursing and healthcare concepts. By the end of this course, the graduate is expected to function satisfactorily within the Nurse of the Future Competencies. The Board of Registered Nursing requires that students must be concurrently enrolled in both ADN 234 and ADN 234L, and pass both courses together. They cannot be taken individually for credit.

AJ 135 Introduction to Criminalistics

Description

This course introduces Forensic Science and its role in criminal investigations. It examines the basic methods of collection, analysis, and reporting of evidence and through the development of practical skills in crime scene techniques, concerning types of evidence including computer crime, fingerprints, blood, skeleton, pathology, toxicology, hair, fiber, trace, firearm, tooth mark, biological, accelerants, illicit drugs and forensic chemistry.
