MUST 100 Pro Tools Fundamentals I

Description

The Pro Tools Fundamentals I course introduces fundamental Pro Tools concepts and principles, covering everything an individual will need to know to complete a basic Pro Tools project, from initial setup to final mixdown. Students also learn to build sessions that include multi-track recordings of live audio, MIDI sequences and virtual instruments. Hands-on exercises and projects introduce essential techniques for creating sessions, recording and importing audio and MIDI, editing session media, navigating sessions and arranging media on tracks, and using basic processing and mixing techniques to finalize a production.

MUST 110 Pro Tools Fundamentals II

Description

The Pro Tools Fundamentals II course expands upon the basic principles taught in the Pro Tools Fundamentals I course and introduces the core concepts and techniques students need to competently operate a Pro Tools system running mid-sized sessions. Students learn to build sessions designed for commercial purposes and improve the results of their recording, editing, and mixing efforts. Guided exercises provide experience in setting up sessions, importing media, working with digital video, spotting sound effects, using loop recording and MIDI Merge techniques, and working with virtual instruments. Additional topics include warping with Elastic Audio, applying Real-Time Properties, creating clip loops, applying signal processing, using automation, and using submixes and track groups to simplify a final mix. Together with the first course in the series, Pro Tools Fundamentals I, this course provides the training required to prepare for the Avid Certified User: Pro Tools certification exam.

The Pro Tools Production I course covers the core concepts and skills needed to operate an Avid Pro Tools Ultimate system with HD-series hardware in a professional studio environment. This course builds on the Pro Tools Fundamentals I and II series of courses, providing intermediate and advanced-level Pro Tools concepts and techniques. Students learn to customize the configuration of Pro Tools | HD Native systems to maximize results and improve recording, editing, and mixing workflows. Guided exercises provide experience optimizing system resources, configuring I/O, navigating and color-coding sessions, managing session media, using advanced selection and auditioning techniques, working with clip gain, applying advanced automation techniques, creating submixes and applying parallel processing, advanced mixing and finishing techniques for a final mixdown. This course provides the foundational training for the Avid Certified Operator: Pro Tools | Music, and Avid Certified Operator: Pro Tools | Post certification exams.

VI. DISCUSSION ITEMS/ATTACHMENTS

1. **Elizabeth Ramirez – BoardDocs continued discussion – *No report due to time constraints***
2. **Elizabeth Ramirez – Honors/Non-Honors 508 Compliance**

Elizabeth shared with the committee the DE approval process for honors courses that have non-honors courses already approved for 508 compliance. The procedure will be to complete a Request for Distance

Education proposal in CurriQunet to the Curriculum Committee. The honors course will be approved based on the 508 compliance approval for the non-honors course.

Mike Slavich suggested that in the future, the committee may want to discuss re-reviewing DE Requests on a 5-year cycle, as we do with courses.

3. **Elizabeth Ramirez – Permanent DE Listing on Curriculum webpage**

Elizabeth informed the committee that a Permanent Distance Ed list is now uploaded on the Curriculum webpage. This list shows all courses that have been permanently approved for hybrid/online delivery.

4. **Elizabeth Ramirez – Red Notebook/How to Update your COR**

Elizabeth asked the committee if anyone still used the “Red Notebook” on the Curriculum webpage as a reference? Since this notebook has not been updated since 2008/2009 she wondered if any committee members would have concerns about removing this from the website since in the past few years we have shifted to having a digital curriculum handbook. The committee agreed to the removal of the Red Notebook from the webpage but decided to have it archived on SharePoint. Claudia Rivas volunteered to save the notebook to SharePoint for future reference if needed.

Elizabeth then informed the committee that a recommendation was made to update our current document “How to Update Your Course Outline of Record (COR)” to include a section for Student Learning Outcomes. The suggested language to add is “It is the responsibility of the department or division faculty to ensure that SLO's are present”. Elizabeth asked the committee for input since this guide was made for the curriculum committee as a reference. After discussion, it was decided to not add this language to the current document in order to avoid faculty members contacting curriculum committee members for guidance with SLO questions. Instead it was suggested to add something like, “Please refer to the Outcomes Committee for support and guidance in regards to Student Learning Outcomes.”

5. **Elizabeth Ramirez – Spring 2024 DE Request Deadline**

Elizabeth proposed to the committee the Distance Education deadline for Spring 2024. All Distance Education requests must be granted second read approval at the last curriculum meeting of the Spring 2023 semester in order to be offered online/hybrid in Spring 2024. This deadline was agreed upon by the committee and it was requested that Curriculum representatives share this deadline with their divisions.

It was requested that a document for yearly curriculum deadlines be created. Elizabeth agreed that this was a good idea and will work on this for future use. Once complete, she will share with the committee and post it on the curriculum webpage.
