# ENGLISH FOR TRANSFER

## ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE

The Associate in Arts in English for Transfer (AA-T) Degree is intended to meet the lower division requirements for English majors (or similar majors) at a CSU campus that offers an English baccalaureate degree.

In addition to the courses listed below, the following additional requirements must be met for completion of the Associate in Arts in English for Transfer Degree:

1. Completion of a minimum of 60 CSU-transferable semester units.
2. Achievement of a minimum GPA of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework (some majors may require a higher GPA; students should consult with a counselor for more information).
3. Completion of the 18.5-19.5 semester units in the major with a grade of "C" or better.
4. Certified completion of the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE) pattern; OR the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) pattern.

Students are advised to check with the Counseling Center or Transfer Center for the courses accepted in the English major at the CSU where they seek transfer.
