- Five faculty attended the Online Teaching Conference in Anaheim June 18-20, 2018 The faculty included Alyson Cartagena, Jill Pfeiffer, Steve Tomory, Shin Lui, Jodi Senk along with two OE Instructional assistants, Zulma Calderon and Gabby Olmos, supported by Perkins Funding.
- Rio Hondo, in a partnership between Automotive and KDA, hosted the New World of Work/21st Century Skills and digital badging utilizing Perkins funds this past May. More than eight faculty, counselors, and two instructional assistants attended, along with attendees from other colleges.
