# SOCIAL JUSTICE STUDIES FOR TRANSFER

ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE

The Associate in Arts in Social Justice Studies for Transfer (AA-T) Degree is intended to meet the lower division requirements for various Social Science majors (or similar majors) at a CSU campus that offers a Social Justice Studies baccalaureate degree.

In addition to the courses listed below, the following additional requirements must be met for completion of the Associate in Arts in Social Justice Studies for Transfer Degree:

1. Completion of a minimum of 60 CSU-transferable semester units.
2. Achievement of a minimum GPA of at least 2.0 in all CSU-transferable coursework (some majors may require a higher GPA; students should consult with a counselor for more information).
3. Completion of the 18-20 semester units in the major with a grade of "C" or better.
4. Certified completion of the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE) pattern; OR the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) pattern.

NOTE: Students are advised to check with the Counseling Department or Transfer Center for the courses accepted into the Social Justice Studies major at the CSU where they seek transfer.
