

February 2019 Staff Development PFC Report

While the Staff Development office is hoping to finalize 2-3 more workshop offerings for this spring semester, the following are the current activities/events that are planned:

~26-hour New Faculty Success Seminar (NFSS) for new full time faculty. The initial session took place 1/24/19 and monthly sessions will continue through May. Seminar content includes college policies and procedures, key initiatives such as Student Equity, Guided Pathways, and Outcomes, student support services, effective pedagogical practices, faculty roles and responsibilities, and completion of a peer observation.

~Support Rio Hondo College Leadership Academy's cohort 7 completion of their 10-month experience.

~CCC Digital Learning Day – Viewing room in LR 128 will enable campus based faculty to participate in up to 7 different sessions on February 28th.

~Spring Reflection & Renewal retreat on March 1st at Mater Dolorosa retreat house in Sierra Madre.

~Recruitment and selection of 2019-2020 SanFACC Mentor Program participants.

~Partnering with Basic Skills grants for “Elevating Rigor through Differentiated Instruction” faculty workshop which has reached its cap of 50 participants and includes NFSS participants.

~Review and awarding of summer professional development grants.

~Funding of Online Education professional development including stipends for the completion of the Peer Online Course Review course and attendance at the Online Education conference.

~Professional development needs assessment.

~Providing of professional development support (i.e. organization of FLEX Day keynote and breakout by Melinda Karp) for Guided Pathways Steering committee.

~In conjunction with Basic Skills/Title V, offering a 3-Day Project Based Learning Institute on campus to faculty from May 29th-May 31st.

~In conjunction with Basic Skills/Title V offering a 1 day “refresher” workshop for those who previously participated in a 3-day Project Based Learning Institute on May 28th.
