

## Online Education Summary Report for October 2017

-The committee met October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017, and reviewed the Canvas settings to be changed to “inactive” when students are dropped, instead of “deleted” so retain records of students/ work.

- A motion was made to purchase 25 licenses for Sceencast-O-Matic= 1yr/25 licenses=\$270) for faculty to use to create videos to provide a more “human connection” to students, and to enhance learning

-A Proposed budget was submitted for \$145, 000 for online education support, resources, certification, training, and conference attendance; however, it will probably not move forward at this time; options for seeking grants will be explored, and an equity cohort was created to seek funding.

-\$3500 was allocated for Online Professional Development. The committee voted unanimously to use those fund towards new online Faculty Certification in the amount of \$300 each. There are already 12 faculty signed up for online certification and six have completed the modules thus far. Addition funding will be necessary to continue online faculty development.

-Online counseling has been launched

- A Peer Review Training Guidelines and Check-list form has been approved by the committee to help peer reviewers and faculty being reviewed to have a guide for online courses. The form will be posted online, and in-person training will also be provided once a semester by the Coordinator.
