- I. It is the responsibility of interested parties to follow the necessary procedures for securing a copyright.**

This may include but is not limited to:

- 1. Registering that copyright with the United States Copyright Office.**
 - 2. Acquiring and paying for necessary rights from third parties (paid by the party seeking the copyright) if the creation of the work and/or securing of the copyright requires such acquisition.**
- II. After proper acquisition of copyright, all information secured shall be subject to Copyright Law and must be attributed or otherwise subject to prohibition.**
