

## Recommended Technology Replacement Cycle

Standard III of the ACCJC accrediting standards requires that, *“The institution continuously plans for, updates and replaces technology to ensure its technological infrastructure, quality and capacity are adequate to support its mission, operations, programs, and services.”* Toward this goal, the Enterprise Systems Advisory Committee (ESAC) recommends the college adopt the recommendations below regarding equipment critical to the smooth functioning of the college, both in the classroom and in its operations.

- Audio Visual Equipment – 5 to 7 years
- Network equipment – 7 to 10 years
- Enterprise Servers – 5 to 7 years
- Enterprise Storage – 5 to 7 years
- Academic Servers – 5 to 7 years
- Computers – 3 to 5 years
- Computer Monitors – 7 to 10 years
- Any technology covered under Section 508, the Rehabilitation Act, or the ADA – should be replaced as needed or as soon as possible to comply with changing regulations.

The Director of Information Technology will maintain an inventory of college equipment and will present to ESAC on an annual basis a list of equipment proposed for replacement. As a shared governance committee, ESAC will review this report, make modifications as necessary, and provide support in obtaining the funding necessary to implement these standards.
