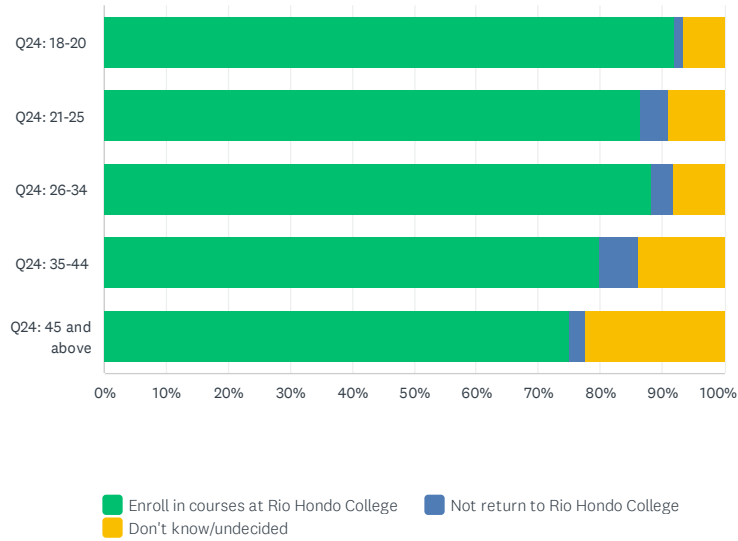

## Q1 What are your current plans for the Spring 2022 Semester?

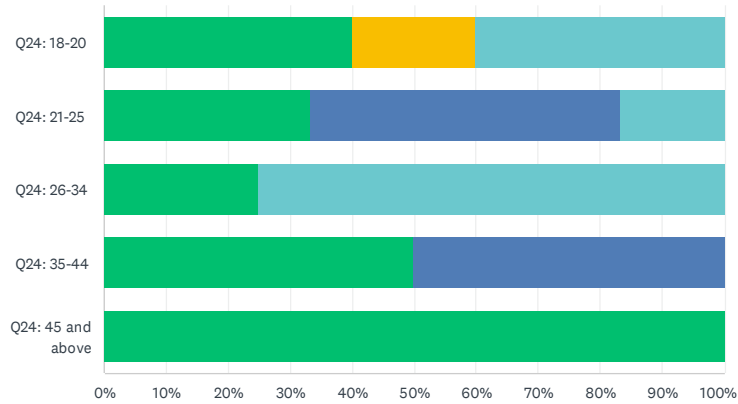

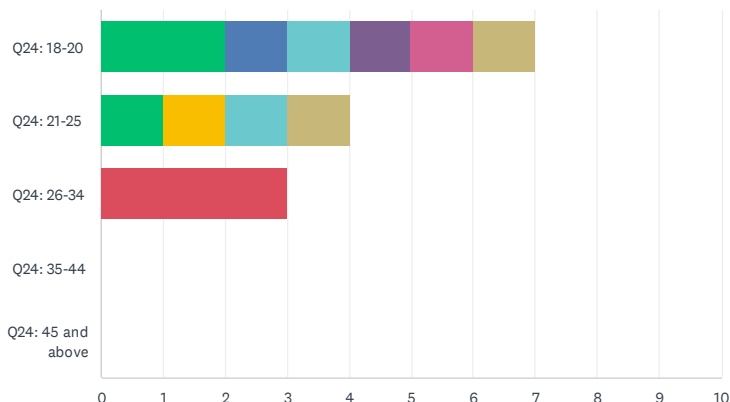

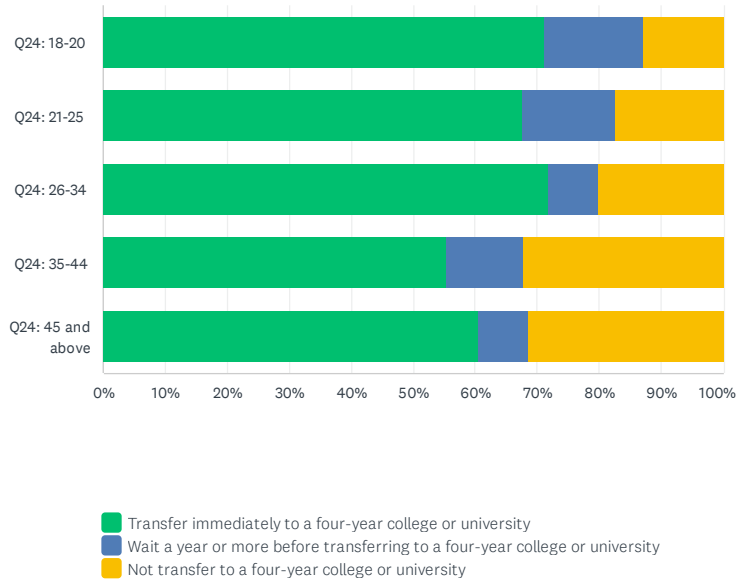

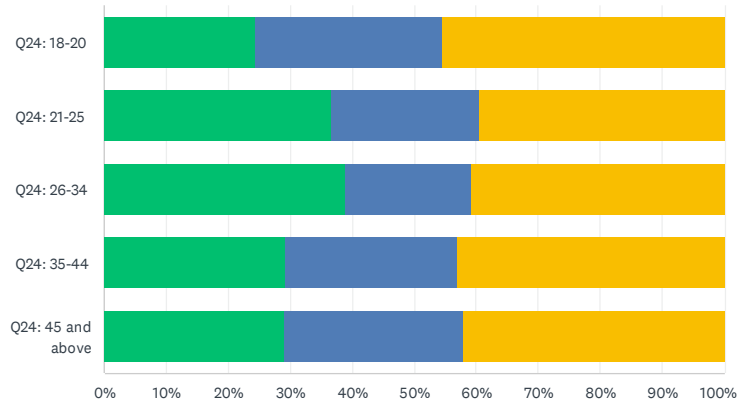

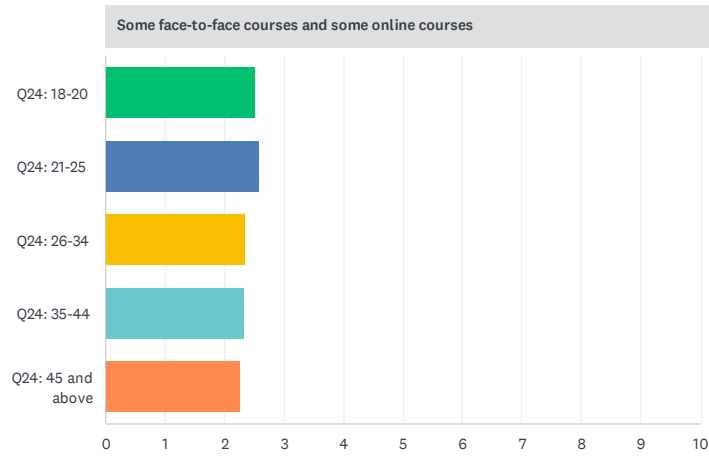

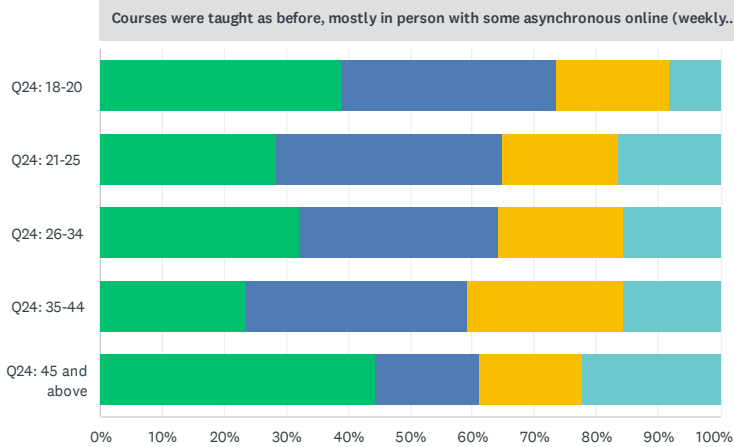

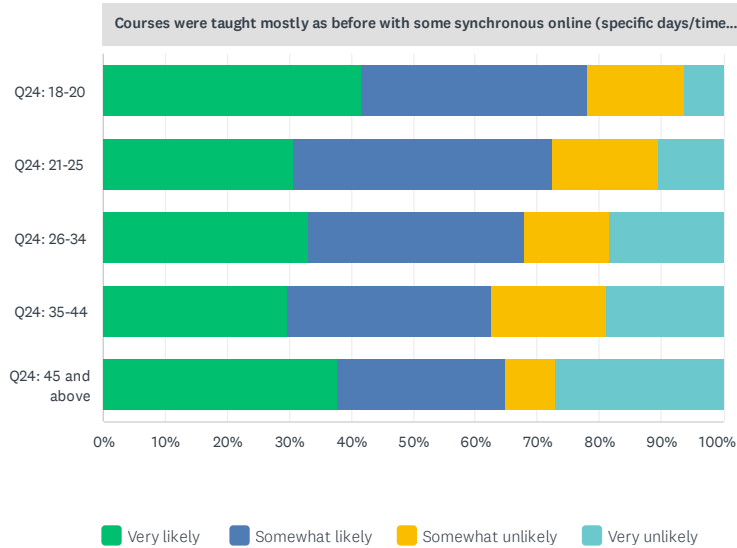

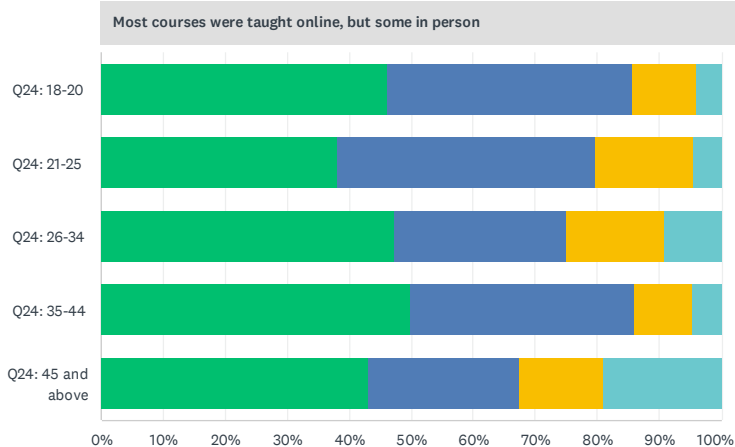


Q12 If conditions improve by Spring 2022, how likely would you be to re-enroll at Rio Hondo if . . .

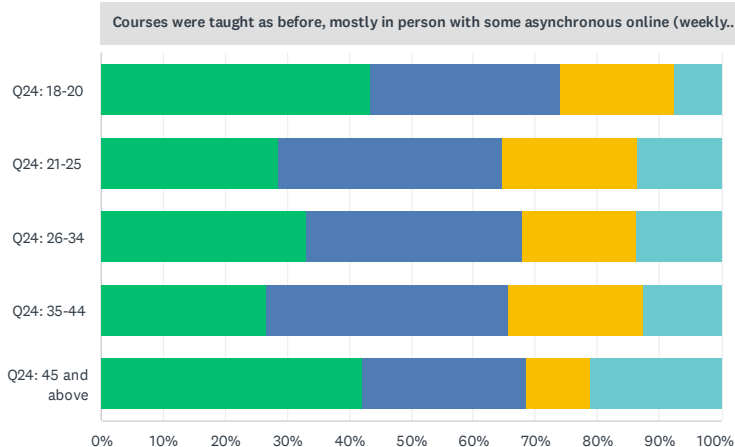

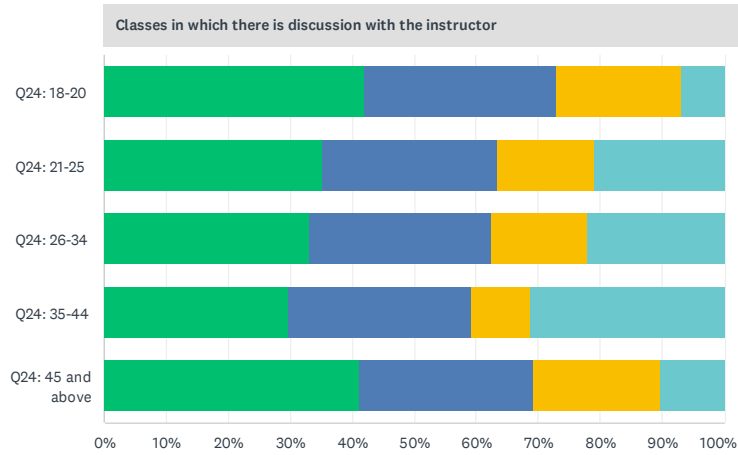


Q18 For each type of class, how important is it to you to be in the classroom rather than learning online?

Q19 For each type of class, how safe would you feel in the classroom?

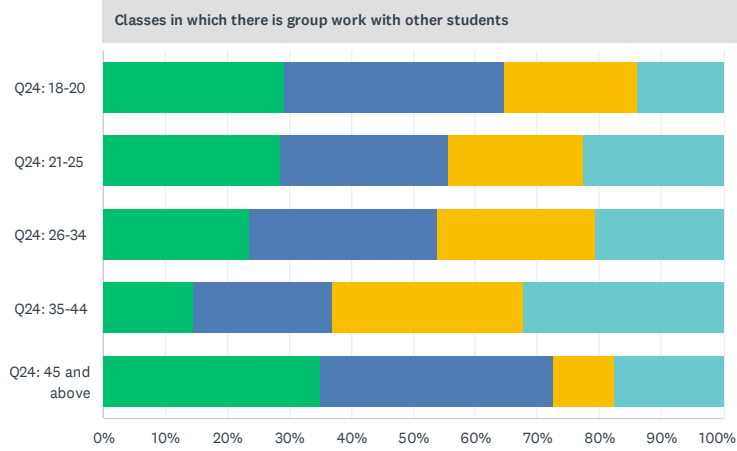

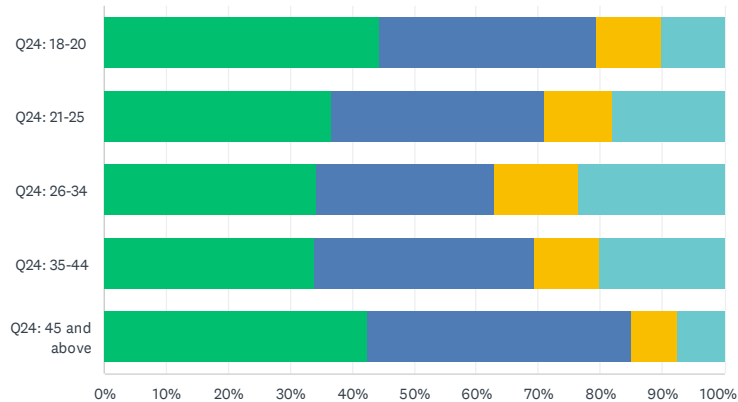

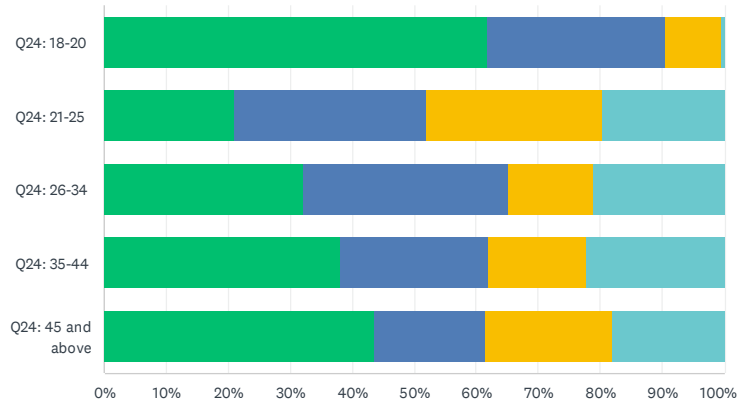

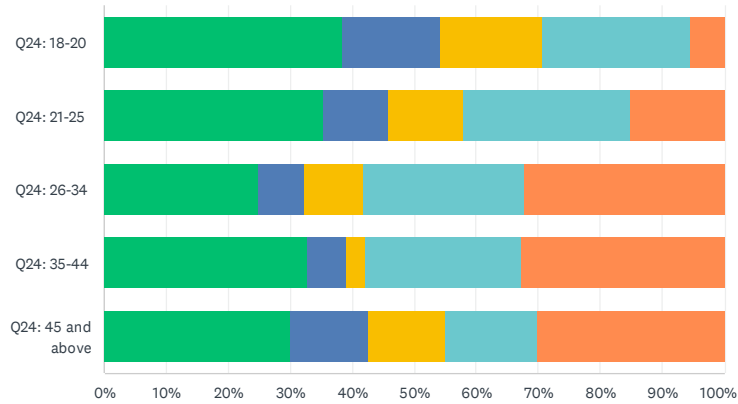
