Courses are flexible and tailored for individuals with busy lives. Our faculty have years of experience working in noncredit programs and bring an exceptional teaching approach to our students.

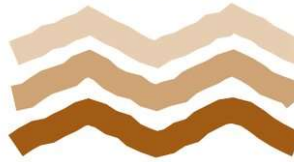

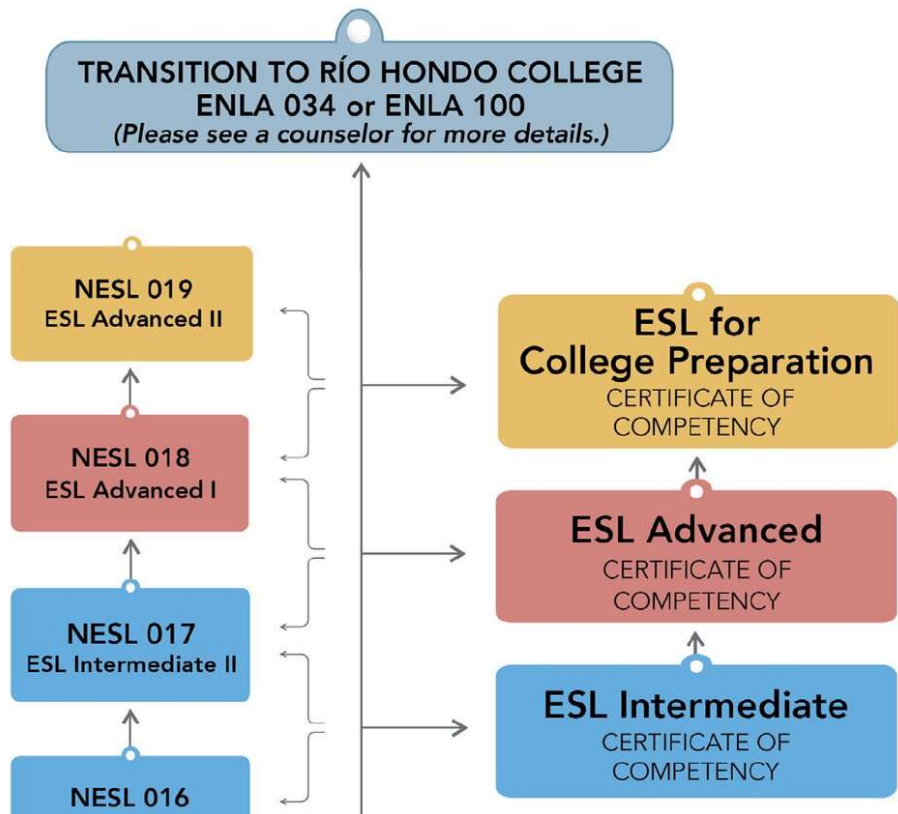

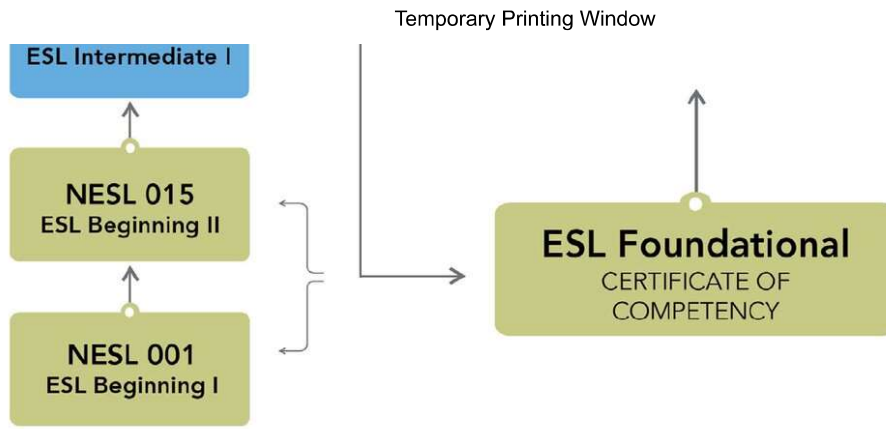

Noncredit (Free/Gratis)

#### ESL Beginning II (NESL 015)

This course is designed to provide an introduction to English speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills enabling the student to satisfy routine demands in social settings. Students develop the ability to comprehend and respond to basic spoken English. Students practice reading and writing at the sentence level. If taken in sequence with NESL 001, successful completion of this course earns a Certificate of Competency in Foundational English as a Second Language and prepares students for entry into NESL 016.

#### ESL Principiante II (NESL 015)

Este curso está diseñado para brindar una introducción al idioma inglés, en áreas de hablar, escuchar, leer y escribir para poder obtener habilidades que demanda la vida actual. #### ESL Intermediate I (NESL 016)

This course focuses on expanding students' listening and speaking skills in face-to-face conversations in social, academic, and work contexts. Students gain ability to read and interpret narrative passages on a variety of topics, and to write simple routine correspondence and short paragraphs. Upon successful completion of this course students are prepared to enter NESL 017.

#### ESL Intermedio I (NESL 016)

#### ESL Intermediate II (NESL 017)

This course focuses on preparing English learners to communicate independently and effectively for a variety of purposes and audiences. Students practice engaging in extended conversations, reading for comprehension of authentic texts, and writing multiple paragraphs with good command of grammar conventions. If taken in sequence with NESL 016, successful completion of this course earns a Certificate of Competency in Intermediate English as a Second Language and prepares students for entry into NESL 018.

## ESL Intermedio II (NESL 017)

Este curso se enfoca en preparar a estudiantes para poder comunicarse independientemente y eficazmente con diferentes audiencias y propósitos. Los estudiantes participarán en conversaciones extensas, lecturas de comprensión y escritura que incluye varios párrafos con buena gramática. ## Noncredit (Free/Gratis), continued



### ESL Advanced I (NESL 018)

This course stresses the refinement and expansion of language skills which enable students to use fluid-paced English to effectively meet social, academic, and workplace demands. Reading for comprehension focuses on factual extraction as well as interpretation using critical thinking skills. Progression of writing skills focuses on the introduction of the writing process and the construct well-developed compositions. If taken in sequence with NESL 017, successful completion of this course earns a Certificate of Competency in Advanced English as a Second Language and prepares students for direct entry to Río Hondo College's Credit English Program.

### ESL Avanzado I (NESL 018)

Este curso se enfoca en el refinamiento y expansión del idioma Inglés en la cual estudiantes tienen la oportunidad de usar sus habilidades en contextos sociales, académicos, y laborales. La lectura de comprensión se enfoca en pasajes así como su interpretación usando el pensamiento crítico. La escritura se enfoca en la introducción del proceso en cómo escribir composiciones. Si esta clase es tomada en secuencia con la clase de Intermedio II (NESL 017) y los cursos son terminados satisfactoriamente, los estudiantes recibirán un certificado de competencia de nivel avanzado

### ESL Advanced II (NESL 019)

The College Preparation course is the highest Noncredit ESL level designed for students who wish to prepare for transition into various academic programs at the college level. This course reinforces and builds on students' English language skills to meet the academic expectations of college courses. Students are introduced to basic elements of an academic course: understanding the syllabus, note-taking, participating in discussion, interpreting written texts, composing essays, and making presentations. Students practice these academic skills in a supportive language-learning community. If taken in sequence with NESL 018, the successful completion of this course earns the Certificate of Competency in English for College Preparation and prepares students for direct entry to Río Hondo College's Credit English Program.

### ESL Avanzado II (NESL 019)

Este curso es el nivel más alto del programa de inglés como segundo idioma. Este nivel refuerza y construye las habilidades en el idioma inglés para poder llenar las expectativas académicas requeridas por el colegio. Los estudiantes son introducidos a elementos básicos utilizados en el colegio tales como tomar notas, tomar exámenes, hacer presentaciones, e interpretar contextos académicos. Los estudiantes practican estas habilidades en un ambiente requerido académicamente. Si esta clase es tomada en secuencia con la clase de Intermedio II (NESL 018) y los cursos son terminados satisfactoriamente, los estudiantes recibirán un certificado de competencia de nivel avanzado en inglés como segundo idioma, a la misma vez prepara a estudiantes para matricularse directamente al programa de inglés en Río Hondo College.
