maximum time allotment for public speakers on any one subject regardless of the number of speakers at any one board meeting as prescribed in Board Policy 2345.

* AB 361 was signed into law on September 16, 2021, in response to the upcoming expiration of Executive Order N-08-21 on September 30, 2021. AB 361 will sunset on January 1, 2024.

AB 361 allows local legislative bodies to continue to conduct virtual meetings under certain emergency circumstances without complying with traditional Brown Act teleconferencing requirements, so long as there is a live comment option for public comments, meetings are paused for any technical difficulties that affect public participation, and each agenda contains information on how to access the meeting as well as how to participate in public comment virtually.

* Executive Order N-25-20 signed by Governor Newsom on March 12, 2020, authorizes state and local bodies to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to attend and to address the local legislative body and waives all requirements in the Bagley-Keene Act expressly or impliedly requiring the physical presence of members, the clerk or other personnel of the body, or of the public as a condition of participation in or quorum for a public meeting.
