## **BOARD ELECTIONS**

I. The term of office of each trustee shall be four years, commencing on the first Board meeting in December following the election. Elections shall be held every two years in odd-numbered years. Terms of trustees are staggered so that, as nearly as practical, one half of the trustees shall be elected at each trustee election.

II. The Board of Trustees has provided for the election of trustees by trustee areas:

Trustee Area 1: (El Monte)\*

Trustee Area 2: (Pico Rivera)\* West Whittier

Trustee Area 3: (North Whittier and South El Monte)\*

Trustee Area 4: Los Nietos, North Norwalk (South Whittier and Santa

Fe Springs)\*

Trustee Area 5: South Whittier (East Whittier)\*

- III. The election of a board member residing in and registered to vote in the trustee area he or she seeks to represent shall be only by the registered voters of the same trustee areas.
- IV. The Superintendent/President shall submit recommendations to the Board regarding adjustments to be made to the boundaries of each trustee area, if any adjustment is necessary, after each decennial federal census. The Superintendent/President shall submit the recommendation in time for the Board to act as required by law.
