The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) requires member colleges to report institution-set standards and actual data on an annual basis. Rather than being aspirational objectives, these standards are similar to dashboard warning lights. If student achievement falls below one of the standards, the college should consider potential causes and plans for improvement. There are six categories: successful course completion, degrees, CCCCO-approved certificates, transfers, passing licensure examinations, and employment. For 2020, the Commission is requiring both aspirational standards and minimum standards. The minimum standard is similar to previous years and can be viewed as similar to dashboard warning lights. If student achievement falls below one of the standards, the college should consider potential causes and plans for improvement. There are six categories: successful course completion, associated degrees, CCCCO-approved certificates, transfers, licensure examination pass rates, and bachelor degrees. The latter two categories apply to specific programs. The 2019-20 standards appear in the table below.
