RIO HONDO COLLEGE HEALTH SCREENING CHECKLIST

All Health Science and Nursing students are required to comply with the HSN Division's health and safety procedure in order to be compliant prior to the first day of clinical in the health care facility. Documentation of student compliance often needs to be provided to the clinical agency up to four weeks in advance. Students are responsible for submitting their documents to Castle Branch for review. It is required that students maintain personal copies of all records and update records six weeks prior to the *beginning* of *each semester*. All certifications must remain current for the duration of the clinical rotation. Students will *NOT* be admitted to the clinical setting until compliance has been cleared through Castle Branch and the Health Science and Nursing Division. *If the student is non-compliant with the health and safety clearance procedure, the student may be dropped from the class for non-compliance.* Faculty will not allow students who do not meet the health and safety criteria into the clinical setting. Re-entry students will be held accountable to the same standards prior to re-admission to the clinical areas.
