

CAMPUS SECURITY AND ACCESS

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- I. In order for the Rio Hondo Community College District to ensure safe and sufficient physical resources at all locations where it offers courses, programs, and learning support services, they will be constructed and maintained to ensure access, safety, security, and a healthful learning and working environment.

During business hours, the District will be open to students, parents, employees, contractors, guests, and invitees. In the case of periods of extended closing, the District will allow access only to those with prior written approval to from the Manager of Operations and Maintenance.

- II. Emergencies may necessitate changes or alterations to any posted schedules. Areas that are revealed as problematic will have regular periodic security surveys. The Director of Facilities and others in concerned areas review these results. These surveys examine security issues such as landscaping, locks, alarms, lighting, and communications. Additionally, during the academic year, the Director of Facilities, Campus Security Officer and Maintenance staff shall meet to discuss campus security and access issues of pressing concern.
