I. Degrees

- A. The Rio Hondo Community College District grants associate degrees and baccalaureate degrees to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted. Students must also complete the general education, residency, and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

II. Certificates

- A. Students may be awarded a Certificate of Achievement or Completion upon successful completion of courses of study or curriculum for which the District offers a certificate. The District offers certificate programs that upgrade and develop occupational and vocational proficiency.

III. Publication of graduation requirements

- A. The District has procedures to determine degree, certificate, and graduation requirements that are published in the District's catalog and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
