- I. The Associated Students shall conduct annual elections to elect officers.
- II. Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students shall meet the requirements in Board Policy #5410.
- III. Have and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA in all college units completed
- IV. Hold a current College Services card.
- V. The President must have 12 units completed at the time he/she takes office in addition to the above requirements.
- VI. Students currently on academic, progress or disciplinary probation shall be ineligible to run for or hold any office.
- VII. The maximum amount of years that a student may participate in ASB is three years. No student shall hold the position of Senator for more than two years, whether appointed or elected. No student shall be elected to the same E-Board position (President, Vice President or Treasurer) for more than one year.
- VIII. No student shall run for or hold more than one (1) elected or appointed office at a time.
