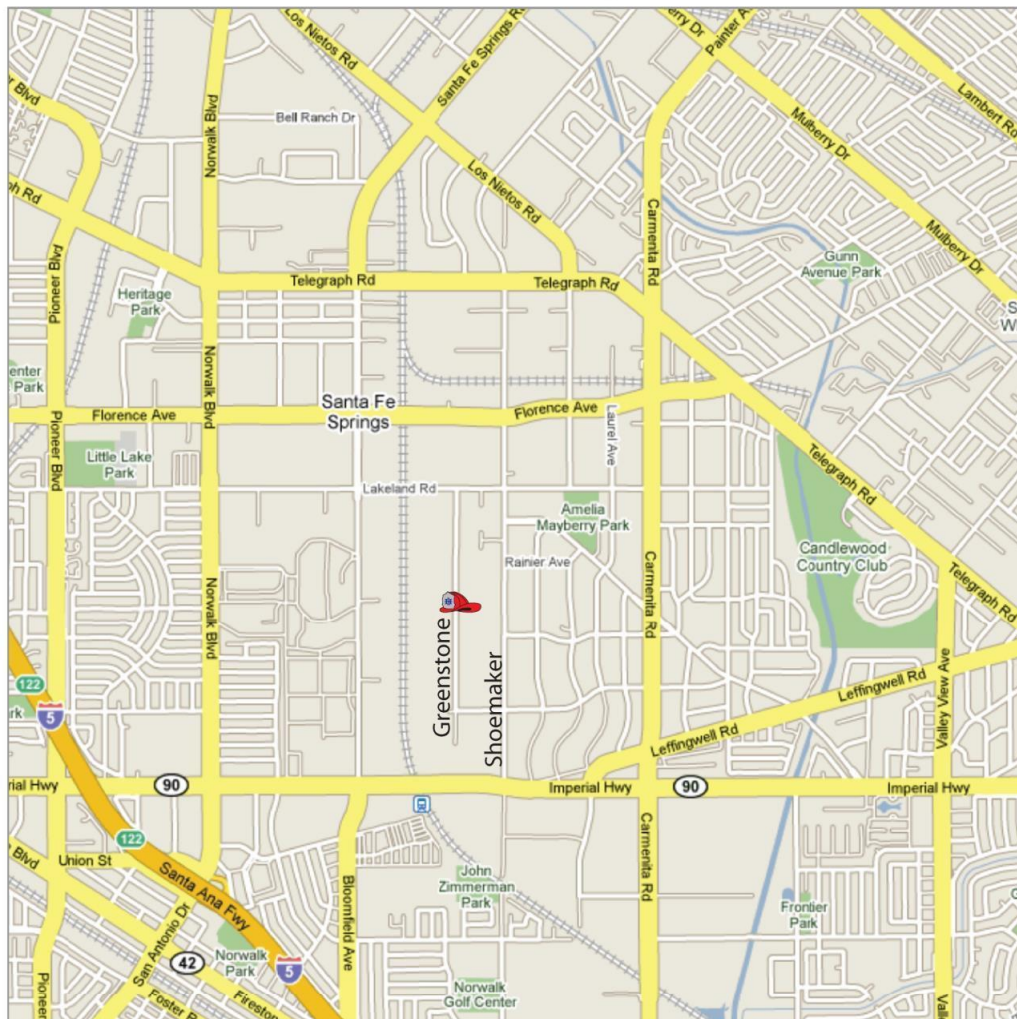

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Standard Work Uniform for classroom lecture
- Full Structural Firefighting PPE
 - Structure Pants
 - Structure Coat
 - Boots
 - Helmet
 - Goggles
 - Gloves
- SCBA
 - With a minimum of two bottles
 - Personal Alarm Device

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT:

- Kneepads for RIC
- Drop / search rope or webbing
- Brush gear for warm days

NOTE:

- This is a physically demanding course. Students should be in good health, without medical issues that may preclude them from participating in all training provided.
- Students can miss 10% (8 hours) of the course and still receive credit. If they must miss more than 10%, they will be allowed to attend the next Truck Academy class (only on those sections missed), at no charge to receive their certification.
- Some days may exceed the time published.
