FIRE ACADEMY APPLICATION INFORMATION & PROCEDURES

Thank you for your interest in the Rio Hondo College Fire Academy. The academy meets the State Board of Fire Services requirements as a California Firefighter I Accredited Academy. Participation in the academy involves arduous physical activity. Topics covered include: organization of the public and private fire service, characteristics and behavior of fire, fire protection systems and water supply, fire hazards and firefighter safety, extinguishing agents and related extinguishing equipment, incident command system, building construction and assemblies, basic fire fighting tactics and strategy, fire prevention, hazardous materials, emergency care, and wild land firefighting.

Students will earn California State Fire Marshall certifications in: Vehicle Extrication, Fire Control I & II, Hazardous Materials First Responder Operational, Confined Space Awareness, Firefighter Safety & Survival, Rapid Intervention Crew Tactics; NWCG S-130, L-180, S-190 certifications.

The information contained in this document is intended to provide you with the necessary information in order to understand the application process for the Rio Hondo College Firefighter I, Basic Academy. The Basic Fire Academy is offered every Fall and Spring semester.

Applications: Fire Academy applications are available at www.riohondofire.com. Please ensure that your application is complete including all the necessary forms and supporting documents. Applications are due by the date indicated. Incomplete or late packets will not be considered. This includes sponsored applicants. You will be notified whether or not you have been accepted into the next fire academy. Student ID: All applicants must have an RHC student identification number. If you are new or a returning student to the college, you will need to complete an application at www.riohondo.edu

Course Prerequisites: All applicants must have:

Verification of Courses: All fire academy applicants must have their course work and prerequisites verified by Diana Valladares, Public Safety Counselor, during the dates and times listed on the application.

Transcripts: Please <u>bring</u> unofficial transcripts with your application when meeting with the counselor. However, official transcripts from the colleges you have attended are also required. Transcripts must be sent to:

Rio Hondo College will not accept official transcripts from students, even if you mail them in a sealed envelope. Transcripts must be sent from college to college. You do not need to request Rio Hondo College transcripts.

Insurance Verification Form:

This form must be submitted regardless if you have insurance or not. If you have medical insurance, please include a photocopy of your insurance card on a separate sheet of paper, enlarged to 150% and copy on lower half of the page.

Selection Process:

Only 50-60 applicants will be accepted to the academy. In-service students (those that are sponsored by an agency) will receive priority over pre-service students. Pre-service students are prioritized according to the number of units completed in Fire Technology related courses with a "C" or better.

Sponsorship:

Seeking sponsorship from a fire department or agency is optional. However, candidates with a signed sponsorship form are securing their candidacy into the academy. The chief, and only the chief, can sign the sponsorship form. Other fire department personnel are not allowed to sign in lieu of the chief.

Tuition and Fees:

The total cost of the academy is approximately \$5000. Half of the amount is for uniforms, books, materials, equipment and gear and the remaining amount covers tuition, registration fees, materials fees and certification fees. Please note that Non-California residents are subject to higher enrollment fees.

Financial Aid:

In order to qualify for the fee waiver (BOGW) or a grant, you must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available at www.fafsa.edu.gov. The school code for Rio Hondo College is 001269. To apply for the Dream Act, go to: www.csac.ca.gov/dream_act.Financial Aid.

Medical Physical Exams: Physical examinations are required for the fire academy. It is important that important that you start this process soon so that the results are ready by the application due date. The physical examination form has been provided for your convenience. Please take this form to your personal doctor or health care provider.
