Employee Case

On Friday, November 6, 2020, Río Hondo College was notified that a construction site employee working on the L Tower project tested positive for COVID-19. The last day this infected employee was at the construction site was Monday, November 2. All crew members on the project were following all safety procedures by wearing masks and maintaining physical distancing. Although all safety guidelines were followed, for precautionary reasons, four (4) other jobsite workers who may have been in close contact with the infected crew member were asked to quarantine and seek testing. Upon learning of this positive case, Pinner Construction sanitized all portable restroom facilities and sanitizing stations. No Río Hondo College employees nor students were at risk for exposure from this COVID-19 case at the L Tower construction site.
