Employee Cases

On December 3, the College was notified that a crew member tested positive for COVID-19. Pinner Construction notified Del Terra that the individual who was working on the site tested positive after taking the test on December 1. The individual was working with other crew members who have since tested negative. The site restrooms and man lift have been wiped down following protocol. Pinner has provided an incident report as required by OCIP. The worker has not been back to the site since November 30.

The College was notified that an employee tested positive for COVID-19 on November 30. The last day this employee was on campus was on November 16. Based on the facts gathered, no other employees were at risk for exposure. Out of an abundance of caution, and as an immediate response, to protect the health and safety of our workforce, an external vendor thoroughly cleaned and sanitized the affected office with CDC approved disinfectants

Student Case

A Public Safety Division student tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last present at the Fire Academy in Santa Fe Springs on November 24. The student experienced symptoms on November 28, began quarantine on November 29, and got tested on November 30. No other individuals were at risk for exposure (defined as being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes during a 24-hour period within two days from the onset of symptoms by the infected individual). An external vendor thoroughly cleaned and sanitized the affected spaces with CDC approved disinfectants.

We hope all will recover quickly.
