



Transfer Center Workshop Descriptions

1. **Learn about the Transfer Center in 10 minutes-** Are you short on time? The Transfer Center can provide a quick 10-minute overview on our upcoming events.
2. **Transfer 101 (60 minutes)-**This workshop provides an in depth look at the transfer process (CSU/UC), requirements, planning, programs, assistance. We will go over the higher systems of education and incorporate tips and best practices to help students achieve transfer success.
3. **Transfer Basics (30 minutes)-**This workshop is designed for first-time college students. It provides a general overview of the transfer process and highlights transfer programs which the transfer center deems beneficial for first time college students.
4. **UC Application Workshop (60 minutes)-** Ready to transfer to a UC? Confused about when and where to apply? This workshop will provide you tips before you begin the application (e.g. documents needed, deadlines, etc.)
5. **UC Personal Statement Workshop (30 minutes)-** This workshop is designed to give students an overview of the UC Personal Statement. Students will get information and tips on writing a strong personal statement. Students that attend this workshop will also be eligible to a follow-up one-on-one personal statement review by a Transfer Center specialist.
6. **CSU Application Workshop (60 minutes)-** This workshops gives a step-by-step demonstration on how to fill out the CSU Mentor application. We will discuss the documents needed before students begin the application, important deadlines, and discuss next steps.
7. **UC TAG (60 minutes)-** Do you know what the UC Transfer Admission Guarantee program entails? This workshop will give students an overview of the requirements for TAG. Come learn the benefits of TAG.
8. **Private School Information Workshop (60 minutes)-** Is a private school university the right fit for you? Come and learn about the differences between private and public colleges/universities, for-profit and non-profit institutions, specialty schools, liberal arts colleges, etc. We will highlight the pros/cons of a private school education and discuss the affordability of it, while also debunking myths about private institutions.
9. **ADT Workshop (60 minutes)-** What is the ADT? What are the defined eligibility requirements? What benefits does this pathway provide students who apply to the CSU and graduate with an Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T)?
10. **What's Next- CSU/UC Workshop (60 minutes)-** Did you recently apply to a four-year university? Waiting to hear about your admissions status? Attend this session to find out what you should be doing during your last semester at Rio Hondo College. Topics covered include: application document deadlines; supplemental applications, navigating university student portals, applying for financial aid, GE Certifications, accepting admission to one campus, and what to expect once you are the university.
