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General Nursing Program Requirements

Generic ADN Applications and LVN-ADN Career Ladder Applicant:

- High School graduate or equivalent (GED, college degree). Attach proof at the time of application
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended must be sent to RHC Admissions and Records (transcripts must be processed by the time your application is reviewed) <u>https://www.riohondo.edu/admissions/records/transcripts/</u>
- All prerequisites must be completed at the time of applying (no in-progress courses)
- Overall college GPA of 2.5 or higher

LVN Application

- High School graduate or equivalent (GED, college degree). Attach proof at the time of application
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended must be sent to RHC Admissions and Records (transcripts must be processed by the time your application is reviewed) https://www.riohondo.edu/admissions/records/transcripts/
- All prerequisites must be completed at the time of applying (no in-progress courses)
- Overall college GPA of 2.5 or higher

CNA Applications

• 16 years of age minimum



- Government-issued photo ID
- SSN or ITIN number
- RHC ID

There are no waiting lists for any of the programs. If you apply and are not accepted or do not start, you will need to reapply to the program

Application Periods

Generic ADN Applications and LVN-ADN Career Ladder:

Two application Periods per year – August/March

One application period per year – August

Two application Periods per year – August/March

All applications must be submitted by 4:30 PM on the last day of the application period.

ADN Program Requirements and Overview

Two Options

- Generic ADN Program
- Associate of Science Nursing major courses plus general education (completion of a GE Pattern, RHCGE, CSUGE or IGETC)

Career Ladder Bridge LVN-to-ADN Associate Degree

- LVN to ADN (Associate Degree)
- LVN to RN (30-unit option, No Degree)
- The number of students accepted is based on available spaces and determined by attrition in the Generic ADN first-year students.

LPT (Psych Tech to ADN) Associate Degree

• May challenge Fundamentals course. Equivalency credit is given for the Mental Health Course.

ATI TEAS

- Required at the time of application
- Minimum overall score of 62%
- Scores must be sent directly to the school through the ATI website

- Multi-Criteria Point System

• **SN or ITIN** - Clinical facilities utilized by Río Hondo College nursing programs require students to have a **Social Security Number** (SSN) or **Individual Tax Identification Number** (ITIN) to participate in clinical rotations scheduled in their facilities. It is <u>not</u> possible to progress through the nursing program if the student does not have an SSN or ITIN number. This is required for all Nursing programs

Science Prerequisites

- Biology 125 (Human Anatomy)
- Biology 226* (Human Physiology)
- Biology 222* (Microbiology)
 - All science classes must be 4 units minimum with a lab component and must be completed within the last 7 years.
 - All science classes must be completed before applying and must be in-person classes.
 - Minimum Science GPA of 2.5
 - Can repeat only one science course, one time for a better grade in the last 7 years (i.e., C to replace F, A to replace B)

Other Prerequisites

- Minimum Overall GPA of 2.5
- English 101 with "C" grade or better (or AP Scores must be sent to Admissions and Records)
- Math Class (Intermediate Algebra or higher, Math 130 recommended, needed for BSN)
 - English and Math must be completed before applying

Other Requirements

- *Chemistry 110 (This is a prerequisite to Biol 222 and 226)
- General Education Requirements for AS Degree

Career Ladder/Bridge LVN/ADN 30-Unit Option (Non-Degree)

Science Prerequisites

- Biology 226* (Human Physiology)
- Biology 222* (Microbiology)
 - All science classes must be 4 units minimum with a lab component and must be completed within the last 7 years, and a maximum of 4 W's.
 - All science classes must be completed before applying (no in-progress coursework)
 - All science classes must be completed before applying and must be in-person classes.
 - Minimum Science GPA of 2.5

Other Prerequisites

- ADN 075 Transition to LVN to RN (only once selected)
- Must have current unencumbered California LVN License

Other Requirements

- *Chemistry 110 (This is a prerequisite to Biol 226 and 222)
- 1-year of RN curriculum (2nd year of program)
 - NO general education required/No Degree.

NOTE: This option has limitations. Obtaining an RN license with this method will not allow for transfer out of state or work in the military. Also, the license will have a notation indicating "non-graduate".

Starting - August 16, 2025, to September 9, 2025, Spring 2026 Start, and thereafter

Update: The Perquisition Science course taken after March 01, 2025, for the Rio Hondo College Vocational Nursing Program will no longer accept online science courses to meet the prerequisites.

Applicants are required to submit syllabi from the Biology 125 course

- VN 61 and VN 61L (random selection) Offered in the Spring Only to those selected into the program

- HS Diploma or Equivalent (submit proof)
- Official Transcripts from ALL institutions attended (Admissions and Records)
- Overall GPA of 2.0
- General Education (only if you want a Degree)

Application Requirement:

- Applicant must be 16 years of age
- SSN OF ITIN NUMBER If you are selected for the CNA program, you'll need to provide either a social security number or a tax ID number.

- Official Transcripts must be submitted to Admissions and Records before applying to any nursing program
