

Río Hondo College University of California (UC) Fall 2026 Application – What's Next?

Apply to UC

October 1, 2025 - December 1, 2025

FAFSA or CA Dream Act

October 1, 2025 and March 2, 2026

Complete your 2026-2027 <u>FAFSA</u> or <u>CA Dream Act</u> application and include all the schools you are applying to.

Check E-mail and University Portal

December 2025 - Summer 2026

Read all campus emails carefully and check your student portal "To-Do List" for required documents. Some campuses may request a supplemental application or initial transcripts. Submit all documents by the stated deadlines to avoid jeopardizing your admission.

Transfer Academic Update (TAU)

January 31, 2026 (priority deadline)

<u>Update your UC application</u> to ensure the campuses you applied to have your most current academic information.

- All students must log in to your application and complete the TAU even if you don't have any coursework to update.
- TAUs need to include grades through Fall 2025 and planned coursework through Summer 2026.

Provisional Admission Decisions

March 1, 2026 – May 1, 2026

Admission offers are provisional until your final official transcript is received, and all UC eligibility requirements are verified. Each campus will outline specific admission conditions that must be met before you can enroll.

Statement of Intent to Register (SIR)

June 1, 2026

Accept your admission offer and pay the required enrollment deposit to secure your spot. Each campus will provide a Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) form or online link to submit your decision.

Wait until you receive decisions from all campuses before submitting your SIR. You may accept only one offer, and the \$250 enrollment deposit is nonrefundable.

Final Official Transcripts July 1, 2026

Official Transcripts and Test Scores

To finalize your admission, submit all **official documents**, including transcripts from all colleges and universities attended and **AP**, **IB**, **or CLEP scores** if applicable.

- Official transcripts must be postmarked or submitted electronically by July 1.
- Official AP, IB, A-Level scores, and any IGETC or Cal-GETC certifications must be submitted by July 15.

IGETC or Cal-GETC Certification

Certification confirms that Río Hondo College has verified your completion of lower-division general education requirements for **IGETC** or **Cal-GETC**. Request certification during your **final semester** by one of the following methods:

- Completing a graduation petition using IGETC or Cal-GETC.
- Completing a graduation petition for the General Education Breadth Certificate (IGETC or Cal-GETC).
- Meeting with a counselor to request certification.
- Selecting the certification option on your final transcript request.
