1. In *CurrlQunet*, in the form section **Textbooks/Instructional Material**, you have four options: Textbooks, Manuals, Software, and Other.
 - a. Although the books listed in the CCN Template are textbooks, both print and OER, to ensure that content is being copied and pasted as instructed, you will place this content in the **Other** section.
